

## **Spruce Cliff Community Association accomplishments:**

**New play structure at Spruce Cliff Park** located behind Wildflower Arts Centre.

Discussions for a replacement of an aged structure on the site started in 2010; that lead to this valued, highly used community amenity.

The new structure and surfaces were installed in June 2011 with funding partners from Boardwalk for density modifications on their new building, and a grant from the Calgary Parks Foundation





## **Evolution of the old tennis courts to the current Sports Court:**

Project grant applications for funding from Calgary Parks Foundation started in 2011, conversion to the sports courts surfaces proceeded first in 2012 with the addition of more benches and picnic tables and the upgrades to the area landscaping / fencing being finished in 2016 after delays to fit in the major facelift to the parking lot and new joint use building construction.

New Building: the CA was involved in all meetings with the Bow Cliff Seniors, Calgary Lawn Bowling Club and the City regarding the new community building.
