

Westbrook Local Area Planning Project Update

Working together, we're creating a local area plan (LAP) to help guide growth, change and redevelopment in the Westbrook Communities (Wildwood, Spruce Cliff, Westgate, Rosscarrock, Shaganappi, Glendale, Killarney/Glengarry, Glenbrook and portions of Richmond and Upper Scarboro/Sunalta West).

Redevelopment is a natural part of a community's life cycle, which often begins when communities reach a certain age and homes, buildings and amenities need to be revitalized or replaced. When a neighbourhood reaches an age and stage when revitalization and redevelopment naturally start to happen, a local area plan is a helpful tool to have in place. Through local area planning, we look at the fabric of a specific local area, the community's vision for the evolution of the area, the ideal places to accommodate growth, and how to make the best use of limited land – to enhance places and spaces to live, work and play.

Over the fall, we've been working closely with our Westbrook Communities working group and community association representatives to reconnect on the project following some impacts on timelines due to the Covid-19 pandemic. We've created an initial draft of the first chapter of the local area plan, based on feedback and input collected through initial public engagement (fall 2019 – spring 2020). The first chapter of the local area plan outlines the area's rich history (PAST), the area as it exists today (PRESENT), the vision for the area and core values that support this vision (FUTURE).

Starting Nov. 22, 2021, we'll be reaching out to people living in the Westbrook LAP area to get their feedback on draft Chapter 1 content. You'll be able to provide your feedback online at calgary.ca/westbrook, at our "My Idea Station" – a little library/engagement station that's coming soon to the Spruce Cliff Community Association, and you'll also receive a survey in the mail. Public engagement for this phase closes Dec. 10. We hope you'll get involved in planning your community's future!

New Public Art for Spruce Cliff

A small unveiling ceremony was held on October 28th to celebrate the completion of a new functional art installation in Spruce Cliff. The installation is comprised of a lit Community Sign and three structural wind blocking pieces. The sign is a much-needed addition to the Spruce Cliff Community and will be shared by The Bow Cliff Centre 50+, The Calgary Lawn Bowling Club and Spruce Cliff Community Association to advertise upcoming events.

The designs for the pieces were conceived during four community multicultural art workshops that focused on cross-cultural and traditional ways of art making. Community residents produced paintings that were incorporated into the final art pieces. If you look closely at the pieces, you will see traditional Ukrainian Easter Eggs, Ethiopian motifs of coffee beans, and traditional indigenous symbolism.

Thank you to the artists who made this wonderful project come to life. And to Heather Gibbons our Neighbourhood Partnership coordinator from The City who has worked tirelessly with the various partners over the last 4 years. She should be very proud of what she achieved!


