Often the work the CA undertakes is not immediately visible, we encourage you to join us in 311 service requests for things like graffiti cleanup, shopping cart pickup, and asking for assistance to address things like social disorder in our park spaces and trip hazards on uneven sidewalks. The adage See something – Say something applies not just to reporting crime. To help our emergency responders, if you live in a property with a lane, please add your address numbers to your rear fence or garage.

Good news - Spruce Cliff Crime Activity was Down in January 2022

Spruce Cliff experiences an average of 6.2 crimes per month. On an annual basis, Spruce Cliff crime statistics are down 14% compared to January 2021. Total Spruce Cliff crimes are calculated as the sum of break & enters (dwelling, commercial, and other premises), theft from vehicles, theft of vehicles, assaults (nondomestic), commercial robberies, street robberies, and non-domestic 'other' violence.

To break down January 2022, there were 2 street robberies, 1 non domestic violence, 1 theft from vehicle & 1 theft of vehicle. Over the last year, there were 16 Break & Enter crimes & 39 vehicle related crimes. Keep vehicles locked!

How does Spruce Cliff compare to neighbouring communities? Very well! In January 2022, there were 5 crimes reported in Spruce Cliff, 10 in Wildwood, 19 in Rosscarrock & 23 in Killarney/Glengarry.

How To Report Crime In Spruce Cliff: Dial <u>911</u> for emergencies or crimes in progress. For non-emergencies dial <u>(403)</u> <u>266-1234</u>. To report a crime anonymously, contact Crime Stoppers at <u>1-800-222-8477</u> (Talk, Type or Text), submit tips online at crimestoppers.ab.ca or text tttTIPS to 274637.

What Else Can I Do To Secure My Home and Property? The Calgary Police Service encourages Calgarians to establish a 9 PM Secure Your Home and Property Routine before heading to bed. The routine recommends: Removing valuables from vehicles | Ensuring vehicles are locked, windows are closed and if possible, parked in a garage | Closing garage doors and windows | Locking any person-doors in the garage, including those leading into a house | Checking that all house doors – front, back, side and garage – are locked | Ensuring all windows are shut | Turning on an exterior light.
