We continue to raise the safety concerns of traffic speed on Spruce Dr, 37th St and 8th Ave-these streets continue to see the higher residential densities putting the most people at risk. Higher speeds increase severe accident outcomes, increase noise levels and contribute to poorer air quality





Spruce Cliff Crime Report

In the past 12 months, Spruce Cliff experienced 36 vehicle-related crimes, 63% of which were "thefts from vehicles".

Compared to August 2022, Spruce Cliff has had a 4% decrease in criminal activity. Connected neighborhoods resulting in a safer community.
