UNDER CONSTRUCTION

You don't have to travel far in Spruce Cliff to see the significant amount of construction happening within our community. With city wide blanket rezoning and H-GO (Housing-Grade-Oriented) allowed along Spruce Drive, 8th Ave SW, 37th Street SW & Poplar Road developers are at an all-time high buying up many properties. You will notice even more shovels in the ground this spring. The Spruce Cliff Community Association Civics Committee is asked to comment on all Development Permits (DP's) within the community. If these DP's follow the terms outlined in the Westbrook Local Area Plan and as set out in the Land Use Bylaw, the comments are often limited to landscaping, safety and privacy concerns. There are currently a couple of controversial large Development Permits on the books. Did you know you can comment and give your feedback to the city planning department? Visit <https://developmentmap.calgary.ca> zoom in on Ward 6 or type in Spruce Cliff and spend some time looking at the various plans for the neighbourhood. You can provide your feedback on each development before the comments are closed for each file. Get involved and make your voice heard!

Telus Tower – There is a proposed installation of a 35m Monopole Telecommunications Tower behind 7 Spruce Cliff Center SW. TELUS will host an open house on February 27, 2025 5-7pm at the Calgary Hellenic Banquet Hall (1 Tamarac Cres SW) Learn details of the project and submit your comments which will be sent onto the City of Calgary.

The CA has submitted a response to the city's Established Area Growth and Change 2025-27 request to identify needed improvements for communities seeing density increases. Our response included the mobility safety concerns many of you have raised and others identified in the City's public engagement on the Westbrook Local Area Plan. Also identified are the deteriorated conditions of the engineered walkways that replace east/ west streets in the community. There will be an open house put on by the City of Calgary /Engage on March 8th 11-2 pm at the Wildwood Community Center -4411 Spruce Drive SW to discuss the areas of concern within Spruce Cliff and Wildwood.

The adage See something – Say something applies not just to reporting crime We encourage you to continue to submit 311 Service Requests for things you observe that need attention- like: graffiti cleanup, shopping cart pickup, assistance to address social disorder in our lanes & park spaces, removal of dead trees and missing or uneven sidewalks and potholes

What Can I Do To Secure My Home and Property? The Calgary Police Service encourages Calgarians to establish a 9 PM Secure Your Home and Property Routine before heading to bed .Don't miss locking up doors between house / garage.
