Happenings in the hood



Construction is underway throughout our community. **Did you know you can share comments and feedback with the City's planning department?** Visit <https://developmentmap.calgary.ca>, zoom in on Ward 6 or search for Spruce Cliff, and review current neighbourhood applications and plans. You can comment on each development before that file's feedback period closes. Get involved and make your voice heard. **The official Development Map is a secure way to submit input and ensures your email address and phone number are not shared.**

There are a couple of larger scale projects: the corner of Bow Trail @ 37th Street and the Spruce Cliff Downs site that may advance in the next while. The Spruce Cliff Downs project submitted a revised proposal for Land Use that goes to Calgary Planning Commission on Sept 24th this step proceed to a Development Permit application.

Chinook Learning will not be moving into the Spruce Cliff School this year. The renovation quotes exceeded budget, a revised estimate has been submitted for AB gov't 2027 capital considerations. In the interim this **August through November the site will be used as a staff training centre for the October Referendum vote.**

Quarry Road Trail will be closed AGAIN, this time in the lower east section for Enmax pole work...Sept 15 to Mid Nov. **And Douglas Fir Trail (east) and the Natural Park Area continues to be evaluated** see updates here <https://engage.calgary.ca/DFT>

The Community Association responded to the City's Established Area Growth and Change 2025–27 request. We shared safety concerns about getting around the neighbourhood, including issues residents raised and concerns noted during the City's Westbrook Local Area Plan engagement. We also pointed out the poor condition of the **engineered walkways** that replace some east-west streets in Spruce Cliff. **Progress Update: Mobility says Spruce Cliff's walkways will be repaved by November 2026, and one of the highest density residential streets in the area has been signed a safer 40 km road speed.**

On the **Spruce Drive Pathway Improvements** – your feedback is being consolidated into a plan – see the latest version (not final) on the [Spruce Drive Pathway Improvements | Engage](https://engage.calgary.ca/sprucedrive) engage.calgary.ca/sprucedrive. **The Next Open house is planned for Sept. 15 6 to 8 PM at 3375 Spruce Dr SW.**

Urban Forrest – With the advocacy of the Community Association Spruce Cliff was the recipient of a significant tree planting program this summer- new trees planted to help offset the loss of private trees on redeveloping lots. **More are planned for 2027.**

The adage See something – Say something applies not just to reporting crime We encourage you to continue to **submit 311 Service Requests** for things you observe that need attention- like: graffiti cleanup, shopping cart pickup, assistance to address social disorder in our lanes & park spaces, removal of dead trees and missing or uneven sidewalks and potholes

To help our emergency responders, if you live in a property with a lane, please add your address numbers to your rear fence or garage. Dial **911** for emergencies or crimes in progress. For non-emergencies dial **(403) 266-1234**. and **311** for service requests to city administration.

A reminder - properties with a lane, you are responsible to maintain vegetation to a maximum height of 150mm to the centre line, this reduces fire risk and helps with visibility of discarded paraphernalia.

We extend sincere thanks to the volunteers and donors who contributed to the Beautification and Community Care projects this spring and summer. These initiatives would not be possible without your support. Your efforts are widely noticed and appreciated, **and they have made a meaningful contribution to presenting our community as a safe, welcoming, and well-cared-for place to live and gather.**
